Storage and Handling

Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep away from heat and ignition sources. Protect from freezing, high temperatures and direct exposure to sunlight. Not to be used under 5° air or surface temperatures.

Packaging

Recycled content plastic tub. Recyclable at the end of its life. Packed on a wooden pallet with PE shrink wrap.

Shelf Life/Service Life

12 months.

Disposal/Repair

Dispose of contents/container in accodance with licensed collectors sorting instructions. 17 09 04 - mixed construction and demolition wastes other than those mentioned in 17 09 01, 17 09 02, and 17 09 03.

Health & Safety

Ensure good ventilation, and wear personal protective equipment according to your risk assessment, see safety data sheet. Wear safety glasses with side shields due to splashing. When sanding, wear protective P2 dust mask. Impermeable protective gloves are recommended. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using this product. Always wash hands after handling.

Application / Installation

Stir to an even consistency before use, may be diluted to suit individual preferences. Ensure substrate is sound, dry, clean and free from oil, and dust. Drying time dependent upon thickness, temperature, ventilation, air humidity and type of substrate. Average drying time approximately 12-24 hours. Use a fine-grit sandpaper for surface sanding. Before application of paint or wallpaper, use an appropriate primer such as Knauf Wallboard Primer or Knauf Plasterboard Sealer.
